

# Noah Meeko

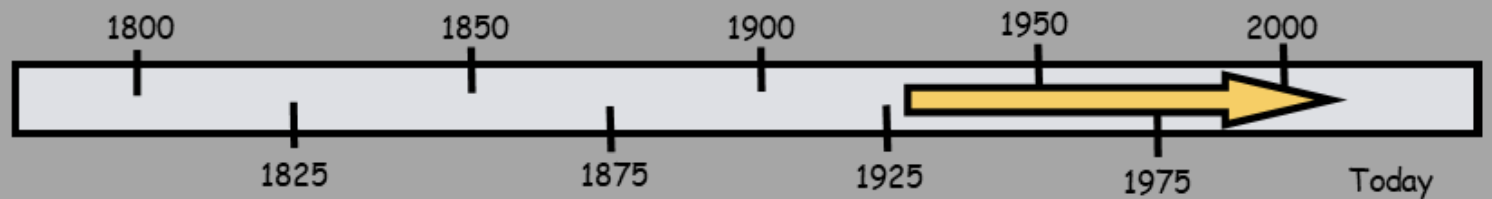
Noah Meeko was born in Sanikiluaq in 1928, but moved to Kuujuaaraapik with his family when he was a child. He is known for his carvings and his printmaking. He carved his own print stones and also carved those of his wife, Lucy Meeko. Some of his prints made from stencilling and silk-screening were presented in the 1973 Print Collection. Noah has also worked with snow sculptures. He participated in national competitions of snow sculpture held in Quebec in 1977 and 1982. His work can be found in collections around Canada and he has been featured in exhibits in Jerusalem and throughout the United States.
