Sylvia is also a producer, a director and a motivational speaker for youth events. She started throat singing when she was about 18 years old, learning from elders and other throat singers her age. She is the co-founder of Aqsaniit, producing shows that promote Inuit culture for special events. She has also collaborated with artists all over the world, including "Think of One" from Belgium, "Tafelmusik" (baroque orchestra) from Toronto and Montreal DJ "Madeskimo".


